VP Operations and Safety as well as your Director of Range Infrastructure and
Improvements. One of my duties is that of your Chief Range Safety Officer and unfortunately
I have to deal with the infractions which I do not like to do but it will be done to the best of my
abilities. This year we have already had infractions of level 1 and level 2. NOT a good start
to the year. It is your responsibility as members to know the club rules and regulations.

These are all posted on the club website as well as everything else you need to know. If you
have questions, ask your executive members. We are always glad to help.

Shoot only at approved targets which are paper targets the gongs or steel targets designed to be shot at.

DO NOT: shoot at pop cans, rocks, plastic jugs filled or not filled with liquid, propane or refrigerant cylinders, paint cans, glass bottles or jars, golf balls, TV's, printers, computers etc.

DO NOT shoot ANY wild life!

If you are caught doing so you will be suspended. This is a 0 tolerance issue and it is not safe.



Responsibilities of members:

As a member of the Medicine Hat Rifle and Revolver you are required to know the club's rules, policies and bylaw as well as the following items.

- Raise and lower RED flag.
- Clean up your brass. It is a safety hazard if left laying on pads.
- Change target boards as required.
- Shoot only at approved targets.
- Watch over your guests or associate members as you are 100% responsible for everything they do.
- Report damage or repairs that need to be done to the VP Facilities or the Director Range Infrastructure and Improvements.
- Cooperate with the RSO's remember they are volunteers trying to keep our range safe.

If you have questions about your responsibilities or what you can and can not do, contact the executive. They are the ones that will give you the correct information.

To be very clear it is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to know and understand the rules, policies and bylaw of the club. There will be no more excuses accepted. We are a small community of individuals that enjoy using firearms for sports, pleasure, hunting etc.We have a wonderful facility and we are trying to make it a better one for all of us and those up and coming enthusiasts.
